Sexual Harassment is NOT Acceptable in the Workplace

Given the high profile media reporting of sexual harassment in entertainment, TV, newspapers and politics it is worth reminding everyone that the Community & Voluntary sector is not immune either.

Members can be assured that any incidents or issues can be raised with Branch staff and will be treated with complete confidentiality.

We can advise members on their options and whether they decide to pursue a claim, or not, we will take all allegations very seriously.

If any members are victims of, or witness to, incidents of sexual harassment they can contact the Branch.

Many incidents occur 'out of sight' and it can be very difficult to get evidence but we can log incidents to identify individuals, or organisations, where there are ongoing concerns.

This can help to build a body of evidence that can be more convincing than an apparently one-off incident.
