### **Equalities Steering Group**

The UNISON Community and Voluntary Organisations Branch are in the process of establishing an Equalities Forum.

The steering group has had a number of meetings and we are working towards a Launch event in February 2018 where we hope to have speakers involved in Equality within UNISON and a number of workshops where you can learn more about organising around Equalities issues.

We have delayed the launch event as over the next few months UNISON conferences for Disabled Members, LGBT members, Black Members and Women Members are taking place. Once these conferences are over the Branch Delegates will be able to feedback some of the highlights at the Forum launch event.

The steering group will continue to meet in the meantime to plan for this event and to discuss motions going to these conferences. These meetings remain open to any member of the Branch with an interest in promoting equality in the workplace.

The Disabled Members conference takes place on the 28th October and the LGBT Conference is at the end of November. At the next steering group we will discuss motions of interest to attendees.
